-1 Provides for suspension of compensation of certain State officers and members of General

It authorizes the Georgia General Assembly by general law to provide for the eli-gibility, procedures for obtaining, and all other giolity, procedures for obtaining, and all other matters regarding such temporary tax relief. It amends Article VII, Section I, Paragraph III of the Georgia Constitution by revising the cur-rent text of subparagraph (a) and adding a new subparagraph (h)
