Eight Panthers crowned Region 8-AA track and field champions

Union County to compete in 28 events at Saturday's State Sectionals in Calhoun

Homer - Union County track and field individually qualified for the State Sectionals in 28 different events while both teams placed second in the team standings during last week's Region 8-AA Championships hosted by Banks County High School.

The Panthers also took home eight region titles from the two-day event that featured field events on Wednesday and the running competitions Hana Gregory claimed

an 8-AA championship in the girl's 800-meter event with a time of 2 minutes, 37.16 seconds - nearly four ticks ahead of teammate Allie Brev. Gregory also placed first in the 1600M race at 5:59.32 - almost 9 seconds better than Rabun

County's Molly Jo Wright.

The girl's 4x400 relay team of Gregory, Riley Allison, Allie Brey and Hannah Long picked up a region title with a season-best time of 4:29.60 - crossing the line 1.8 seconds quicker than Banks

Zander Rotko and Trace Wright took home the top two spots in the boy's 400M dash with times of 53.14 and 53.59, respectively.

The boy's 4x400 relay team of Wright, Rotko, Brady Guild and Elliot Stepps edged Elbert County by 2.5 seconds with a time of 3:37.10.
