cally charged burning material suct as electric wires or motors. A multi-purpose, class ABC fire extinguisher, is the most common and should be sufficient for most homes
The size of extinguisher depend fire. Fire extinguishers for the home range from $21 / 2 \mathrm{lbs}$ to 20 lbs You wer the extinguisher, the more fire that can be extinguished. You want to get an extinguisher big enough to put out a fire but
small enough to be able to use. Most people purchase a $5-10 \mathrm{lb}$.

use it. Almost anyone can use a fire extinguisher. Most people use the P.A.S.S. technique: P. Pull the pin on the fire extinguisher; A.
Aim the fire extinguisher low, with the nozzle pointed at the base Aim the fire extinguisher low, with the nozzle pointed at the base of
the fire; S. Squezze the handle to release the extinguishing agent; S. the fire; S . Squeeze the hande to release the extinguishing agent; S .
Sweep the nozzle from side to side while pointed at the base of the fire until it is extinguished. It is best to familiarize yourself with the use and practice often.
Fire extinguishers

will tell you what the pH of your soil is. Soil pH regulates the availability of nutrients to plants. Therefore, if your pH isn't in the right range you
could be wasting money on fertilizer. With price couldbe wasting money on fertilizer. With price
as high as they are, applying lime early, to get
your pH right is more important than ever Ide your pHe want pH to be 6-6.5.
A soil test will also tell you how much of different nutrients you have in your soil. So, if your soil test tells you that your phosphorus an
potassium levels are in a medium zone you ca potassium levels are in a medium zone you ca them. Soil test reports may include nitrogen in them, but nitrogen is very mobile in the soil an
leaches out easily. That's why nitrogen recol leaches out easily. That's why nitrogen recom-
mendations are usually standardized based o years of research. When taking soil samples avoid areas where animals congregate, these
spots will naturally have higher levels of nutrients. In cattle operations rotational stocking or rotational grazing can increase pasture produc-
tivity by $30 \%$ compared to continuous grazing tivity by $30 \%$ compared to continuous grazing,
The tighter you can make your rotations, the more productivity you will see. That means the fertilizer you do have to use you will be able
stretch it farther with good rotational grazing. With rotational grazing, you also get a more eve
distribution of manure over te field distribution of manure over the field.
