region and discovered that what is believed to be the same three men tried to purchase gift cards from the Dollar General Store in Graham

However, the clerk at that store seemed wise to their game and refused them service as they tried to purchase gift cards at that store, Sgt.

"We've enlisted the aid of the U.S. Secret Service to assist in this investigation," Sgt. Osborn said. "The Secret

Service is the federal arm of investigation regarding counterfeit money. Together, we'll track down where these individuals are working and hopefully bring them to justice.

"We ask everyone, including store merchants to be on the lookout for individuals passing \$100 bills," Sgt. Osborn said. "These \$100 bills passed the pen test. The thing to look out for is that the serial numbers on these bills, the last

four digits are the same.
"It's also come to our

attention that the Atlanta area is on alert for individuals passing counterfeit \$20 bills, that like the \$100s used here, passed the pen test, and the serial numbers are identical," Sgt. Osborn said.

"It's very important to stay on top of counterfeit cash being used at local markets," Sgt. Osborn said. "If counterfeit currency infiltrates our legitimate currency, it can create some serious problems, problems that we want to eliminate quickly.'
