Georgia. Your backdrop is two to 10 miles.

"I would tell him every night - you've got the skills, use your eye and hand coordination and smoke that first one as soon as it gets out of the thrower, because then you've got more time for the other one."

McGillis coaches Union County 4-H Shotgun, and is certified under an array of shooting organizations, including the National Rifle Association, Amateur Trap Shooting Association, National Sporting Clays Association and USA Shooting.

USA Shooting sponsors the National Junior Olympics, and Colwell competed in two events mid-June, the Single Trap and the Double Trap.

The Double Trap event, in which Colwell placed third, is quite different from the 4-H shooting to which he has grown accustomed. In 4-H, the clays fly between 49 and 54 miles per hour. Double Trap clays fly 75 miles per hour, and in varying directions from multiple trap machines.

Those who place in the Top Two positions during the National Junior Olympics can move on to the Junior National Team, where they compete in Junior World Cup shooting events that open up the doors to Olympic trials.

Colwell has already said he looks forward to competing again next year, and that he had a great time in Colorado Springs - he and his mother were able to stay with a cousin stationed at Fort Carson.

"It was interesting, because you got to meet all the kids that were the best in their area or their state," said Colwell of the experience. "You got to see other state's really good shooters, and you got to meet other shooters from your state that weren't involved with 4-H, or other extracurricular activities that involved shooting other than USA Shooting."

Coach McGillis said that, along with placing at an international shooting competition, Colwell has gained valuable experience in his exposure to such a high level of shooting competition.

"We're looking forward

to the development of the new range, where we can train more kids for international shooting besides 4-H," said Coach McGillis. "This is going to be a tremendous advantage for Union County. And seeing as I'm the only USA Shooting instructor that has anything to do with the 4-H, I'm personally

not retiring until I get a kid on the Olympic team."

Colwell joins the ranks of two former Union County 4-H Shotgun Team members - Haley and Haden Green have also done exceedingly well in past National Junior Olympic Championships.

the ballots at 1,471 total votes to Woerner's 493.

Woerner, a former elementary school principal, was able to edge Gurtler by 61 votes in their home county, but it wasn't enough to sway the remainder of the district, which encompasses all of Union, Towns and Rabun counties, along with a portion of White County.

In Towns County, Gurtler received 726 votes (62 percent), and in White County 154 votes (59 percent).

In the May 24 Primary, Gurtler was unable to obtain more than 50 percent of the

required electorate to avoid the Run Off Election, as he collected only 35 percent of votes to Woerner's 23 percent.

Gurtler will run unopposed in November for the District 8 seat, which has been held for eight years by Blairsville attorney Stephen Allison, who decided earlier this year not to run for re-election.
