faced. He released Farner on an OR bond, his own recognizance, Union County Superior Court records show.

Two weeks after his release, the Union County Sheriff's Office investigators were looking into allegations that Farner had molested a third victim. After an investigation by UCSO Investigator Andrew Hammond, charges were brought against Farner again. On Nov. 24, Farner was charged with child molestation and sexual battery, SSgt. Darren Osborn said.

"Basically, we believe Mr. Farner will go to trial on the new charges," Sgt. Os-

born said. "From what I understand, the previous charges, well, it's up to the District Attorney what happens on those counts. I can't speak for the District Attorney."

Farner is being held in the Union County Jail, Sgt. Osborn said.
